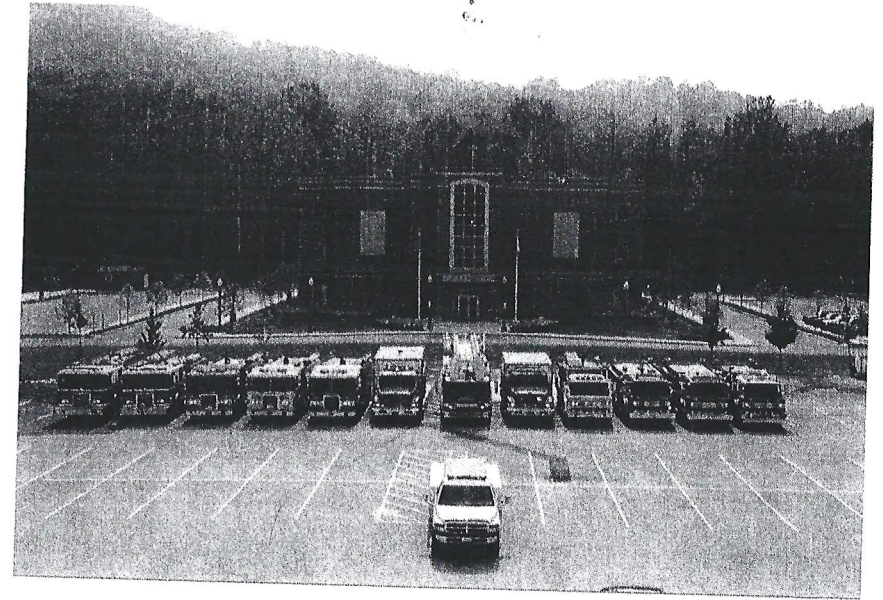

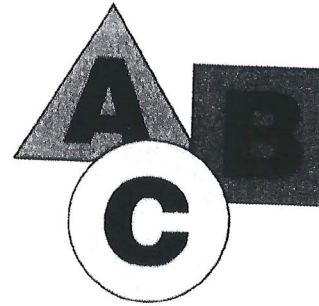

101) VFIS Emergency Drivers Training Course

Instructor-Dana Spade & Kyle Slate, Hurricane Fire Dept

This is a combination classroom and practical skills training on emergency vehicle operations. Safety, legal aspects, inspection and driver responsibilities are covered. Both written and practical examinations are administered. This class meets WV State Fire Commission and WV State EMS initial driver training requirements and recommendations. This course is designed to meet DOT and NFPA Standards.

Pre-requisites: Must have a valid drivers license and be 18 yr. old

102) Advanced Pump Operations

Instructor-Glen Whittington FF. Buffalo Fire Dept.

This class will teach the student the fundamentals of Pump Operations. Tasks covered will include pumping from a hydrant, drafting, pumper-to pumper relay, and hydraulics. This is a combination of classroom and hands on course.

104) Vehicle Fires
