NFPA 1403 (April 13)

FRIDAY EVENING (6-8pm)

All students in live fire training must attend.

ADVANCED STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTING (April 14)

SATURDAY (1 DAY)

Class will cover interior structural firefighting techniques. **All students must have Firefighter I. All students must have full firefighter PPE, SCBA, and spare bottle. No facial hair permitted.**

GAS LINE & SPILL EMERGENCIES (April 15)

SUNDAY (1 DAY)

Class will cover firefighting techniques and control for various gas line fires and spills. Using the new props of WVU Fire Academy firefighting techniques will be used to control and extinguish fires. **All students must have full firefighter PPE, SCBA, and spare bottle. No facial hair permitted.**

VEHICLE FIRES (April 15)

SUNDAY (1 DAY)

Class will cover firefighting techniques involving vehicles and discuss the dangers involved with the many alternative fuels used in vehicles today. Using the props of WVU Fire Academy using safe techniques learned will control and extinguish vehicle fires. **All students must have full firefighter PPE, SCBA, and spare bottle. No facial hair permitted.**

BASIC AUTO EXTRICATION (April 14/15)

SATURDAY / SUNDAY (2 DAY)

Class will cover extrication tools and basic techniques for auto extrication. This course will involve hands-on practical training involving various scenarios and address scene safety, incident management, and vehicle stabilization. **All students must have full firefighting PPE, gloves, and eye protection.**

AERIAL OPERATIONS (April 14/15)

SATURDAY / SUNDAY (2 DAY)

Class will cover basic aerial operations and safety in the fire service. Ladder truck placement and function as well as safety will be discussed. Hands-on operation scenarios using an aerial apparatus will test the student's ability to control the ladder function. **All students must have full firefighting PPE**
